S&B USA Construction is ranked as the 12th largest construction contractor on the Pittsburgh Business Times’ list. Its parent company, S&B USA, has been awarded two contracts totaling \$425 million for projects in the Pittsburgh area over the past year, as well as a \$1.2 billion flood diversion project in Fargo, North Dakota. Another one of S&B USA’s subsidiaries, Joseph B. Fay, recently landed a \$270 million contract from the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission for the Beaver River Bridge Project. S&B USA says that it expects to continue pursuing “more projects of similar stature.”
